

Individualized Learning Plan (ILP) Process

- Student takes “Learning Style Preference Survey” in advisory to determine learning style preference
- Discuss the meaning of the “Learning Style Preference Survey” with Advisor
- Identify strengths, and areas where the student most needs to growth
- Brainstorm interests student wants to incorporate into his or her learning
- Identify the goals student has and/or goals from learning team (parents, advisor, exhibition panelists) recommendations
- Select three potential Internship focuses
- Incorporate feedback from advisor, parents
- Identify the learning standards student will focus on: MC² Habits, Habits of Mind, Habits of Being, Basic Skills, and Essential Knowledge

ILP goals will be used in determining schedule choices
